Catholic University of Applied Sciences Mainz (CUAS Mainz), is a state-recognised university with faculties for Social Work and Social Sciences, Practical Theology, Health Care and Nursing. The responsible body is the Gemeinnützige Gesellschaft zur Förderung von Wissenschaft und Bildung mbH of the (arch) dioceses of Cologne, Limburg, Mainz, Speyer and Trier.

The core remits of the university include application-related tuition, research and further education. Catholic University of Applied Sciences Mainz qualifies its graduates to become technically competent and socially responsible experts and managers.

Studying at the CUAS Mainz is not bound to a denomination. Exceptions are the study programmes Practical Theology and the double degree programme Social Work and Practical Theology, which require the membership in the Catholic Church.

CENTER FOR MEDIA LITERACY OF THE GERMAN BISHOPS' CONFERENCE AT CUAS MAINZ

The Church is active in many ways in the field of media education, for example by providing information, education and advisory services. A central objective of the Center for Media Literacy is to pool these services of the Church to impart media competence and to represent these services in cooperation with partners within and outside the Church.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CENTER FOR MEDIA LITERACY INCLUDE IN PARTICULAR:

- The pooling of media educational offers of dioceses, associations, congregations and educational institutions in order to create an overview of the Catholic Church's services and opportunities with regard to media education.
- Networking with church and non-church institutions and actors in the various fields of education in order to better use the existing resources of church media literacy teaching.
- The participation in congresses and conferences as well as the clarification of points of view of church media pedagogy by subject-specific papers and tools.
- The realisation of advanced trainings, conferences and projects for the mediation of media competence with selected cooperation partners.

The interests of participants, relevance for actual practice as well as the promotion of reflection and development play a vital role in the implementation of the concepts that are developed.



DOUBLE DEGREE IN SOCIAL WORK AND PRACTICAL THEOLOGY

The double degree programme Social Work and Practical Theology combines the perspectives of both disciplines. With this degree you qualify for diverse fields of work at the interface of social work and pastoral care. The double degree programme leads to two Bachelor's degrees in 10 semesters. State recognition as a social worker / social pedagogue is an integral part of the degree.

- · and you meet the requirements for studying at a university in Rhineland-Palatinate.

then studying Practical Theology (B.A.) might be the right thing for you. Usually, it leads to the profession of parish assistant. The fulltime degree course begins in the winter semester and lasts six semesters.

The degree course includes theological disciplines, vocationoriented spiritual development as well as human sciences and methods of professional practice.

Three internships are completed during the study programme (community / school / project).

A semester abroad is possible.
