

### BAPT Annex 3: Study plan

Abbreviations used: s: written examination (e.g. written exam, course work, essay, portfolio), m: oral examination (e.g. presentation, oral exam), Prak.: Internship

A slash "/" between two or more forms of course examinations means that they are available for selection. The lecturer will inform the examination board before the start of the course which form of examination is to be used in the current case. The examination board will take into account the overall examination load of the semester concerned and work towards an even distribution of the various forms of examinations. The examination board will determine the form of examination in consultation with the tutor. The lecturer(s) will inform the students at the beginning of the module/component which form of examination will be used.

See examination regulations §7 (2) and §8 (2) for the respective examination duration. Examinations will be conducted in such a way that the expected average workload for the examinations together with the other workload for the module corresponds to the assigned credit points.
